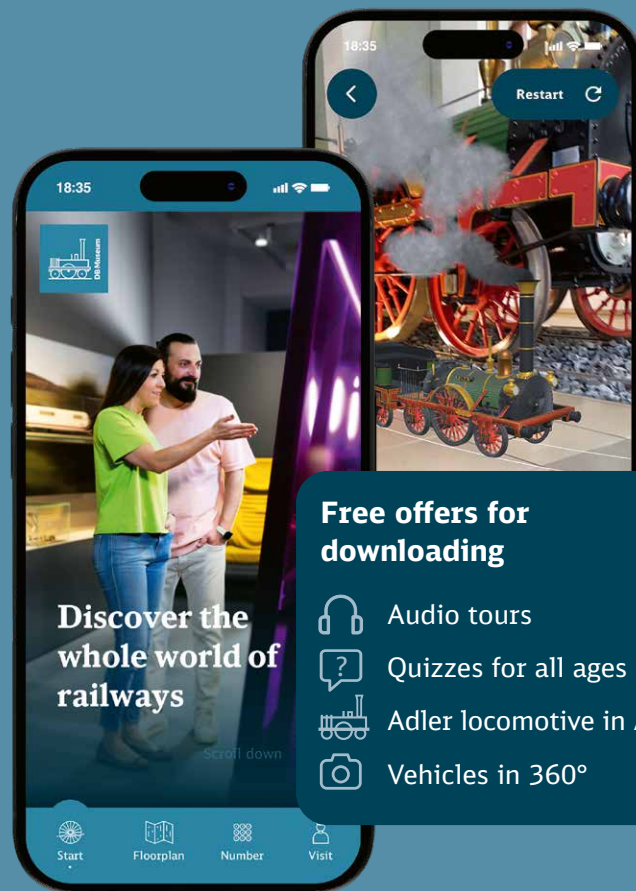
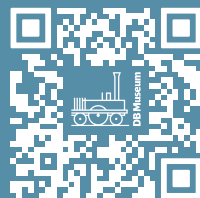

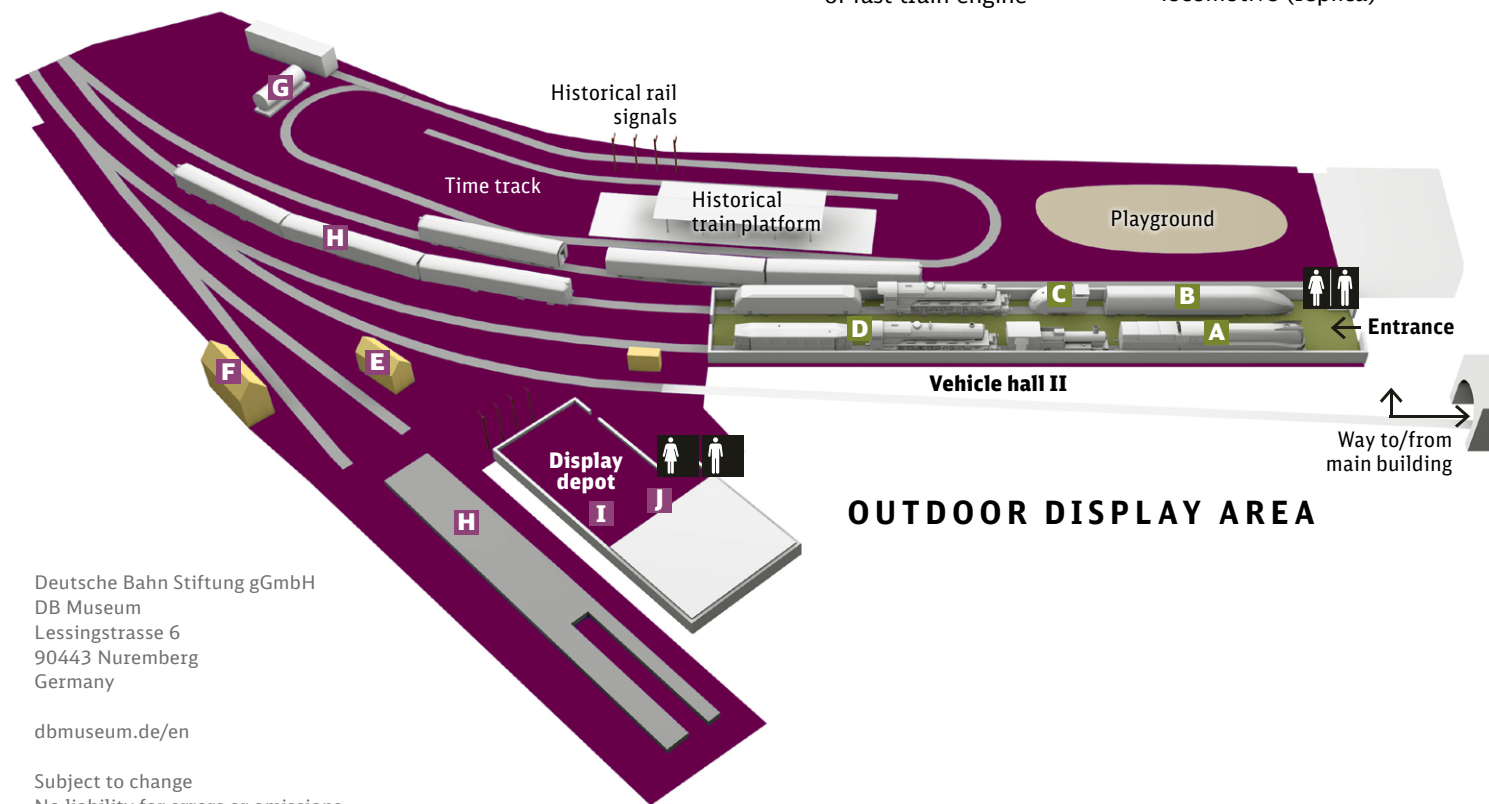


- A** 05 001 High-speed steam locomotive

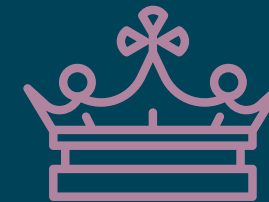
